The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	Monday 13th November 2023
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Monday 27th November 2023

Number of Offers made and accepted under each criteria:	<p>Priority Category 1: An Applicant Student who is a member of one of the Trustee Churches or Protestant reformed church or is a member of a minority religion which has the same religious ethos, or a similar religious ethos to the programme of religious instruction/education which is provided in the school¹ and who lives within the parish boundaries of Christ Church Bray. 7 places offered, 6 places accepted.</p> <p>Priority Category 2: An Applicant Student who is a member of one of the Trustee Churches or Protestant reformed church or is a member of a minority religion which has the same religious ethos, or a similar religious ethos to the programme of religious instruction/education which is provided in the school and who lives within a 10 km radius of the School. 2 places offered, 2 places accepted.</p> <p>Priority Category 3: An Applicant Student who has siblings currently attending the school. 4 places offered, 4 places accepted.</p> <p>Priority Category 4: An Applicant Student who has a parent who is a <u>current</u> permanent staff member of St Andrew's N.S. 0 places offered.</p> <p>Priority Category 5: An Applicant Student who is a sibling of a former pupil of St Andrew's N.S. who resides within the parish boundaries of Christ Church Bray as defined above. 0 places offered.</p> <p>Priority Category 6: An Applicant Student whose parent is a former pupil of St Andrew's N.S. and who resides within the parish boundaries of Christ Church Bray as defined above (not exceeding 25% of applicants). 1 place offered, 1 place accepted.</p> <p>Priority Category 7: An Applicant Student who resides within the parish boundaries of Christ Church Bray as defined above.</p>
